CGIAR system priorities for research 2005-2015

System priority 1: Sustaining biodiversity for current and future generations

- System to continue and extend its key role in conservation of genetic resources
- CGIAR focus should move to use of collections
- Part of a rational, coordinated, forward-looking global system

- **Changing way of working**
- **Need to measure performance for CGIAR funding**
- **Need to show progress**
- **Donor requirement**



Focus of system-wide genebank activities

- **Managing crop agrobiodiversity as a global public good**
- **Meeting commitments under the International Treaty**
- **Working towards best practices**



SGRP principles

- **Collective action**
- **More than the sum of the parts**
- **Addressing common issues**
- **Learning from each other**
- **Increased efficiency and effectiveness**





Expectations for performance indicators

- **Suitable for use in a global system**
 - Crops
 - International and national genebanks
- **Clearly show changes towards new ways of working**
- **Easy to measure**
- **Quantifiable**
- **Fit for purpose**





Considerations

- **Challenge of identifying indicators for generic use but suitable for specific genebanks**
- **Flexible but replicable**
- **Need to compromise for wide applicability**
- **Practical**
